The Hospital for Sick Children in Toronto, Canada is currently accepting applications for our 1 year Neonatal Surgical Critical Care Clinical Fellowship.

Fellowship Overview

The NICU Surgical fellow is responsible for managing the surgical patients in the NICU in collaboration with the surgical Neonatal Nurse Practitioner, Pediatric Surgery Residents and the Neonatology team. This includes rounding on the patients each day, identifying problems and developing a plan, participating in family and multidisciplinary meetings and acting as a liaison between the surgical staff and neonatal team.

The trainee will develop the cognitive and technical skills required in the care of neonates with surgical problems, as well as skills in the realms of communication, collaboration, leadership and ethics particular to the field. There are also research opportunities with faculty members in Pediatric Surgery, Neonatology and other allied specialties.

Qualifications

Candidates must have completed their Adult General Surgery or Pediatric Surgery training.
