This year course will primarily have a focus on anorectal malformations with its wide spectrum of presentations, treatment and outcome. Topics that are dealt with include neonatal diagnosis, screening and management, surgical management (single stage procedures, multiple stage procedures), the specific role of minimal invasive treatment. Furthermore, postoperative care, clinical outcome, follow up and transitional care will be discussed.

The faculty is international and experienced in the field of pediatric colorectal surgery. The course is endorsed by ERNICA and eUROGEN, both European reference networks for Anorectal malformations (and Hirschsprung disease).
