



EUPSA Colorectal Surgical Masterclass 2025

This course will cover both theoretical as well as practical aspects of pediatric colorectal surgery. This year it will primarily focus on all aspects of Hirschsprung Disease. The course will be interactive with panel and audience discussions, video presentations, and hands-on training. Topics that are dealt with include classification, diagnosis, surgical and non-surgical management, pathology, and complex cases including the treatment of total colonic Hirschsprung. Other topics to be discussed are, postoperative care, clinical outcome, follow up and transitional care.

The faculty is international and experienced in the field of pediatric colorectal surgery. The course is endorsed by ERNICA and eUROGEN, both European reference networks for Anorectal malformations and Hirschsprung disease.
